UCATS



The Union County Agency Transportation Service (UCATS) has been providing transportation to residents since 1999. As a government agency, UCATS is dedicated to strengthening the community by supporting individuals and families through compassionate, demandresponse transportation. Currently, operating hours are 8 AM to 4:30 PM. UCATS offers rides to eligible Union County residents for medical appointments, errands, and other essential needs. Transportation is available to seniors aged 60 and over, individuals with an ADA disability, the Veterans Services Commission, Union County Department of Job & Family Services, and Facilities with a UCATS contract. Funding for trips comes from multiple sources. Some of the sources are federal, state, and local grants, ensuring essential rides remain free of cost and accessible to the community.

New client paperwork must be filled out and received prior to scheduling a ride. Paperwork can be found at <u>unioncountyohio.gov/ucats</u> or requested over the phone or in-office at 940 London Avenue, Marysville. To schedule a ride, contact the UCATS dispatch line at 937-642-5100 or toll-free at 877-488-2287. Approval of each trip is based on availability. When scheduling, please allow at least one working day (24-hour) notice for in-county transportation and three working days (72 hours) for out-of-county transportation. We look forward to hearing from you soon!

Rideconnect is a volunteer program to help transport individuals to medical and non-medical appointments and work.


Ridconnect's goal is to eliminate gaps that exist because of the lack of cross-county and region-to-region transportation.

ODOT Projects in Union County



US 42 Resurfacing: Summer 2025-Fall 2026

 Resurface U.S. 42 from U.S. 33 to State Route 745, including pavement repairs, shoulder widening, and the addition of centerline and edge-line rumble strips. The project also includes constructing turn lanes at the intersection of U.S. 42 and Jerome Rd.

U.S. 33 Resurfacing and Bridge Rehabilitation: Spring 2025-Fall 2027

 This project includes replacing the bridge deck on U.S. 33 over Raymond Rd. and Waldo Rd., replacing bridge beams on U.S. 33 over SR 245, and performing a bridge deck overlay with abutment repairs on U.S. 33 over Northwest Parkway. Additionally, U.S. 33 will be resurfaced from SR 245 to U.S. 36.

SR 38 Bridge Repairs: Fall 2025-Summer 2026

- This project will rehabilitate the bridge on State Route 38 over the Big Darby Creek near the intersection of Burns Road in Darby Township, Union County, Ohio.
- Construction is anticipated to begin during the Summer of 2025. Traffic will be detoured for up to 180 days.


EMERGENCY RIDE HOME PROGRAM



The MORPC Emergency Ride Home (ERH) program is a free service that assures commuters taking alternative modes of transportation to and from work won't be stranded in the case of an emergency, illness, or unexpected overtime. It's a foolproof benefit meant to ease the minds of commuters who carpool or vanpool, bike, or take the bus to work, and need to get home quickly.

The program is now allowing registered users to take their emergency rides with the licensed rideshare provider of their choice (Uber, Lyft, or a taxi provider). Users will pay for the ride up front and be reimbursed via a mailed check within 4 weeks after uploading their receipt on gohiocommute.com/morpc.

Be the first to know before you go. With the OHGO app, drivers get real-time traffic updates, personalized route notifications, can view live traffic cameras, and get accurate delay times.


